Greetings everyone!

Happy Easter! If you are spending it with family and friends, no doubt it will be a happy holiday. Otherwise this Easter is a solemn and serious occasion, for obvious reasons. However, as usual we start with news at home. We had to vote in a referendum here this past weekend. Our right-wing government under Meloni wanted to change the Italian constitution in seven places. The vote was about making changes to the judiciary branch of government. The ultimate aim was to ensure a victory for Meloni in the coming elections next year. That is how many people here saw it, anyway. All but three of Italy’s regions voted the measure down. The three regions that voted in favor were all in the north, where more conservative and separatist parties are in influence. The rest of Italy saw what the current administration was trying to do and rejected the referendum. However, the no vote was not by a wide margin. Italy, like so many other Western European nations is facing political upheaval. This is happening because of Europeans rightly recognizing that the central EU powers in Brussels do not represent the views of the European populace, and who have consistently led Europeans down a path to austerity and economic hardship. This has been done by design, using narratives like Russo-phobia, net-zero policies, immigration and so on to keep the public subdued and divided. That is set to change in the coming years.

Further afield, as in Jerusalem, Catholic [Cardinal Pizzaballa was denied entry into the Church of the Holy Sepulchre](#) to celebrate mass on Palm Sunday, denied entry by the Israeli police. This is the first time in centuries that such an act is taken place. The Christian world, aside from American evangelicals, is up in arms. This comes at a time when certain parties in the US and Israel are seeking to turn the Ramadan War against Iran into a religious conflict. To be clear, this war has nothing to do with religion, which we will cover shortly. But the refusal of this cardinal to be able

to enter the sepulchre is a sign of things to come, along with many other signs. It may be of interest, but the younger set in the MAGA movement are beginning to turn away from evangelical beliefs and are instead [embracing Catholicism in increasing numbers](#).

Ominous signs: If one believes in omens, there have been omens in Israel and the Persian Gulf regarding this war and its outcome if nothing else. Firstly, there was [a murder \(swarm\) of crows in Israel](#) about a week ago, which was taken as a very negative omen regarding Israel. Crows are rather intelligent birds, one of the very [few species of birds who have learned to use tools](#). Birds also have a highly developed etheric telepathy and they have a keen sense of their surroundings. One wonders what those crows must be sensing. The next ‘omen’ was the [blood rain on Hormuz Island](#) and the [flooding in the Persian Gulf region](#), where Kuwait and the UAE especially received floods alleged to be ‘of biblical proportions’. This was accompanied by a large [lightning strike to the spire at the Burj Khalifa Hotel](#). The rain that came to the Persian Gulf amounted to a year’s worth of rain falling in a matter of two or three days. There was some conjecture that this happened because the radars arrayed against Iran had been destroyed. [Speculation about such matters will persist](#), but without conclusive proof. We do know the [US government has engaged in weather modification](#) to affect geopolitical ends. But [such flooding in the Persian Gulf is not unusual](#). The [coastal areas of Iran received heavy rain](#) as well which somewhat relieved [drought conditions in that part of Iran](#).

In the West and Southern Europe energy issues have suddenly become a big problem – this due to poor planning, foreign ownership, lack of awareness, and the closure of the Strait of Hormuz to unfriendly powers, which in effect is most EU states. Fortunately, here [in Italy we have over a year’s worth of oil in storage](#) and the energy crunch for transport has not been in evidence. There has been a slight rise in fuel prices, but nothing of major note. In Australia, instead, the situation has become dire almost overnight. There are already a few restrictions. [Farmers are stockpiling diesel](#). [Truckers are at the breaking point due to steep increases in diesel prices](#), which also means that the transport of food and goods has already been impacted. There are reports of people siphoning petrol from cars, an increase in home invasions, and then to top that off China has [stopped the transport of kerosene](#) (which is used for jet fuel) to Australia.

I am supposed to leave for Australia in less than two weeks and at present do not know what I will be facing once I get there. My flight connections have already been changed twice. I was originally supposed to go through Dubai and the airport there has just been bombed. But at least my connecting flights to and from Europe have been changed. We haven’t seen this sort of disruption since the COVID lockdowns. Speaking of change, however, that brings us to our present topic for this letter – the first of the major spiritual festivals for the year, the full moon of Aries.

Aries: Aries, Taurus and Capricorn are the three signs known to be catalytic in nature.² The ultimate ruler of Aries is Uranus, which always brings in a new rhythm, resulting in the Aries equinox each year, beginning the astrological year with all its attendant changes. There is a [report on the Aries ingress on the blog site](#), which you may want to read. Unsurprisingly, Aries is a martial sign, with Mars as the orthodox ruler. It is said that Aries opens the door to Shamballa,³ where the Will of God is known. Moreover, Aries brings in the idea of conflict in the emotional and mental spheres through the influence of Mercury, the esoteric ruler of Aries. But Aries overall is a mental sign, with the Uranian rulership at that level. Aries brings in the mental impulses that find development and fruition in the months following the Easter full moon festival. Hence we have the Aries esoteric motto: “I come forth, and from the plane of mind I rule.”⁴

Easter always takes place in Aries. In the Christian world Easter is the celebration of the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, signified by the stone having been rolled away from the tomb (sepulchre) in the Biblical scripture. The esoteric meaning is clear, if one is inclined to esoteric studies. Easter represents renewal, as does Aries – the conquering of some aspect of spiritual death,

meaning our attachments, our sense of separateness and our ignorance of spiritual realities. Easter represents our emergence into the clear light in spiritual experiences, our 'ascension to heaven', meaning losing our consciousness to the realms of the personality, however briefly that might be, and thereby experiencing the reality that we are neither alone nor separate, that we exist in the 'ecstatic embrace of God's love' (words are inadequate to describe it) and that everything to which we have attached importance in our daily lives has only passing meaning. Those things are simply passing shadows in the eternity of the soul. We the 'Easter experience' the realms of every World Teacher – every 'Christ' Who has been or will be – are felt in those moments. Those experiences change our lives and bestow a new perspective on life. Easter is meant to convey a more spiritual meaning to our lives. We experience this in the highest strata of the mental realm. A new vibration is felt in our minds. But there is a catch.

Having experienced the touch of the World Teacher, as it were, there is no going back to our old modes of life. We know there is more to life than 'chopping wood and carrying water'. We also know that matters in our way of living have to change. This is the Uranian component of Aries. We must impose a new rhythm of life. But what if we find that difficult? Old obligations still exist. The people around us still have their desires and needs. What to do? What to do? Conflicts arise. They arise within ourselves and in our relations with others. This is the Mercurial phase of Aries, leading to the Martial phase – open conflicts with others and ourselves, and/or the dynamic drive for progress in some direction. This is why Aries types can be seen to be so difficult at times. They act as catalysts for change, within society and certainly within relationships. They are 'ideas people', but quite often people around the Aries type do not like or do not care for the ideas the Aries proffers. Aries types both provoke and invoke conflicts, and that is not a bad thing. We often need to be broken out of our old belief systems, and quite often by misunderstanding what the conflict often implies. And that brings us to this full moon and the opportunities presented.

The full moon takes place on 2 April 2026 at 02:12 UTC (10:12 am AEST). This lunation makes for an interesting figure for several reasons. Firstly, the full moon axis forms a t-square with Jupiter at the apex in Cancer, Jupiter being exalted in Cancer. Mars is not in a major aspect with the other planets and is in Pisces, which is a weak placement. The suggestion here is that military action will not be as pronounced in the weeks that follow. Then there is some rather interesting symbolism with the degrees for the Sun and the Moon. Given that the US started this war against Iran, and given that the Sabian symbols are uniquely American symbols, the symbol for the degree of the Sun is as follows:

- A bomb which failed to explode is now safely concealed. 13° Aries

The degree for the lunar symbol is as follows:

- Children are blowing soap bubbles at a youngster's party. 13° Libra

The Moon forms a singleton in a [bucket pattern](#) in the chart. The lunar symbol suggests creative fantasies and relaxation in the context of the inauguration of a new order. The youngsters here represent the emerging order. The solar symbol speaks to our past few years and the realization that often our fears are unfounded. This can especially apply to all the fears we have about the use of nuclear weapons in the present conflict, as well as the fears American families have for their loved ones being put in harm's way in the war in West Asia. We will discuss these points below. In fact, we are witnessing what is very likely to be a new era unfolding in West Asia, as well as the end of an old order, the latter which has steadily impoverished Western nations since the introduction of the petrodollar. That will be covered in the next letter.

Especially in relation to the two symbols just mentioned, we are seeing that the resolution of issues by violence, referring to the United States and Israel especially, ultimately fails. The solar symbol can also refer to the large demonstrations we have seen as in the [No Kings protests](#) in the United States and the [antiwar protests in European](#) countries. These protests, although they show the

dissatisfaction and disgust with which the general public views the West's war on Iran, and also though they show a growing awareness of the public of the insanity of such military action, they have thus far failed to produce any results. General strikes do produce results, on the other hand. Thus we have the symbol of the unexploded bomb being sealed away – the hopes and frustrations of the public coming up against the established orders of the state. The lunar symbol in contrast refers to the collective imagination of what could be once the conflict is resolved – the opportunity for a fairer custodianship and distribution of wealth. The symbol can also represent the materialist's dream of a dystopian world of technocratic control where the few live in luxury while the rest, meaning us, live in servitude. The reversals the latter are facing in this war point to a possible 'sealing of the door where evil dwells', discussed shortly. For the Eastern powers, their dream is for win-win cooperation and an end to the dominance of the US dollar as a coercive measure.

There is also the influence of two of the dwarf planets in this chart, namely Makemake and Quaoar. In a mundane figure such as this one representing collective influences, the dwarf planets will gradually rise into importance. Quaoar forms the apex of a subsidiary t-square to the full moon axis from Capricorn. The Moon is conjunct Makemake. These dwarf planets form a sort of middle ground between major planets and asteroids in the hierarchy of astrological influence. Of the two dwarf planets mentioned, Makemake is the more important of the two in this chart because it is conjunct the Moon. Makemake brings in the dynamic of teamwork, being able to 'read the field', and to be able to do so in a creative manner while collectively moving forward.

Makemake was a creator deity of the Rapa Nui people. Such a dynamic connected with the lunar symbol mentioned above brings in the idea of a more creative and nonviolent collective solution to the issues that led to the outbreak of this war. In the Pisces letter we noted that this war was a precipitation brought out as a result of a long series of events, and thus represented an end-stage prior to the emergence of new reality. That solution or solutions require imagination and more of what we might call the 'team spirit' once the fighting stops and reconstruction can occur. The Moon is the focal point of the chart, being the singleton planet in the bucket formation of the chart. Its placement in Libra also emphasizes the need for cooperative effort and a more constructive approach rather than the destruction we see with military action in the Persian Gulf.

The influence of Quaoar as an opposing t-square to that of Jupiter adds the note of the imaginative use of ritual as an adjunct to creative output. Quaoar is also implicated in financial crises, which produces chaos in our societies. We are currently facing a very major one if this war goes on for much longer. Quaoar's opposition to Jupiter accentuates the crisis in supply that we are seeing as a result of the war, with the closure of the Strait of Hormuz to unfriendly powers. Overall what we see in this chart is an emphasis on the use of creative imagination in overcoming difficulties. [From the blog post on Quaoar:](#)

"Quaoar is suggestive of a creative force which lies beyond human perception. As such it can represent a portal through which something of the primordial mind can be accessed. Quaoar represents the now latent creative force which can be roused into activity for the purpose of bringing a new order to life and renewed creative impulses... Its energies must be invoked, which must be approached through ritual, music and movement. Most of all, though, Quaoar's great gift to humanity comes via the imagination."

There is little more to say about this chart for the lunation, except to note that the bucket part of the chart, represented by the bundle of planets opposite the Moon, represents the passage from Pisces into Aries. The Martian qualities represented by its position in Pisces are quickly giving way to the realities being presented by the planets in Aries. With these thoughts in mind we move on to the current events that have taken place since the previous letter and then onward to what is unfolding before us.

Current events: The previous letter was posted on 25 March, so there is little in the way of current events to report. But of interest, and not mentioned in the previous letter we have the following:

- The [Danish general election was held](#). The Social Democrats who had been leading the government remain the most voted party, but they lack a clear majority. It was the party's worst result since the 1903 election. Negotiations are underway to form a coalition government.
- The Iranian Ministry of Foreign Affairs [addressed a letter to the UN](#), stating that ships not tied to either the US or Israel can pass through the Strait of Hormuz. This will be outlined further below.
- Meta and YouTube were [found liable for social media addiction](#) in a landmark court case in the United States.
- Antimatter particles were [transported by road for the first time](#) in order to assess their stability during transit. This probably means nothing to readers at the moment, but into the future that may have major implications for understanding the origins of the universe and for studying matter at the subatomic level. The experiment was conducted to see if it is possible to transport such material away from other experiments, which reduces interference in measurements of said material.
- There were large No Kings protests in the United States. The protests were against Trump's policies including the Iran War, ICE operations and the January shootings of Renée Good and Alex Pretti.
- Ansar Allah (a.k.a. the Houthis) [joined the Iran war](#) against Israel and the United States.
- Israeli police blocked the Latin patriarch of Jerusalem from entering the Church of the Holy Sepulchre during Palm Sunday. This was referenced above.
- The Knesset passed [a bill allowing for mandatory executions of Palestinians](#) convicted of terrorist attacks that kill Israelis. The Israelis call such attacks terrorism, whereas the wider world calls it resistance. The bill has to pass muster with the Israeli Supreme Court before becoming law.
- Trump gave a rambling Easter lunch speech which was closed to the press. We find out why it was closed when one scrolls to the 19 minute mark in the speech, which is where he throws the American public under the bus in order to be able to finance military spending. The speech was briefly [uploaded to the public, but was quickly taken down](#). However, [you can see the entire thing at this link](#). Other platforms have uploaded the video as well.
- A few hours later he delivered an address to the nation on his Epic Fury at losing the war for the oligarchy. It was full of misinformation and outright lies, contradicted in what follows in the remainder of this letter. It was aimed at his base. [What he outlined is illegal, immoral and will only serve to harden Iran's resolve](#) and prolong the war, much to the pain of the world's citizenry. He essentially stated there will be a ground invasion. Troop movements also indicate it. [The Iranians are waiting for us](#).
- Pam Bondi was finally fired. Pete Hegseth appears to be instituting another purge in the military, having fired the Chief of the Army and other high ranking officials. It appears these people do not agree with current White House policy. [The Epstein cover-up is coming unravelled](#) and the military is beginning to rebel against what they see will be catastrophic losses for the US military if they go further with this clearly ill-thought war of choice.

The lead-up to war: These points bring us to our immediate concern which is the unfolding war between the US-Israeli axis and Iran. The two sides continue to trade blows, with no sign that the Iranians are slowing down or weakening, quite the opposite to [what we hear in the Western press](#). We need to backtrack a few months and think about how we came to this place in order to see where it is likely headed. It is clear now to anyone who has followed this war closely and who knows anything about Iran that this war was foolish to start and was based on a fundamental but

colossal misjudgement. This misjudgement is also known as a lack of good intelligence. Read the latter as you like.

Evidence has emerged that the war was sold to Trump by three sources – David Barnea (head of Mossad), [Netanyahu and Ivanka Trump \(via Jared Kushner\)](#). The claim is that [Trump and much of White House policy is controlled by Jared Kushner](#), Trump's son-in-law. The document making that claim is from a 2020 FBI informant who was considered to be reliable. It turns out the brains behind Kushner is his wife, Ivanka. This is not unknown in marriages, by the way. [There is a thread on 'X' which describes the Israeli part of the miscalculation](#), which is worth reading, but we will not cover it here. The basic miscalculation was underestimating the resolve of the Iranian people, [overinflating the diaspora Iranian monarchists](#) and the real support Iranians in Iran have for their government. Now [we are hearing Trump saying the war could be finished in a couple of weeks](#). The Iranians have other ideas.

Told ya' so: Trump was warned by a few people in the military and in intelligence about the folly of going into this war with Iran. Yet the momentum had already been set via the media and the donor class and the die was cast. The Zionists, who control American media, along with the donor class who largely hold sway within the federal electoral cycles, as well as with Trump's own Zionist leanings decided the evolving fate of the Anglo-American Empire. Now we are starting to see the results of our miscalculations about Iran in our own abilities, results which will be felt long into the future. The markets are crashing, prices are rising already especially for energy, alliances are changing. Yet the American public is told everything is going just swell and that victory is imminent. Then, there is a religious factor.

It is well known that the planners in the US do not study history, do not study culture, and frankly do not care. Due to the culture in Washington just described, the prevalent thinking as it appears is that if we throw enough military might at an enemy then the enemy society will just collapse and we can install new leadership more favorable to us. The Israelis believe this as well. There are three factors these war planners would have done well to study: history, Shia Islam and Persian culture. The military planners in the US and Israel failed to study these factors because of their own hubris and for some, their eschatological beliefs. The Israeli Zionists believe the Israelis are the chosen people and that the entire Middle East region is theirs for the taking, whereas the evangelical leaders within key posts within the US military believe that this war is all according to God's plan.

Carl von Clausewitz, who was a Prussian general and influential military theorist, outlined the problem the West now faces with Iran by citing the three factors just mentioned that they failed to study. Iran is a civilizational state, meaning the culture is very deeply embedded in its people and in the land itself. They have survived for thousands of years. This is to say the culture has remained. It is much the same in China and Russia. There is a resilience within the culture that cannot be defeated by military means. They can always change their views somewhat via generational change, but still the culture and history is deeply rooted. Then there are two factors militarily which are at play here, one being that bombing campaigns do not win wars and do not change cultures. In fact bombing campaigns tend to do the opposite and instead unite people. This has been proven time and again, as in Vietnam, for example. That is part of the historical study that should have been undertaken. Another historical precedent is that it is very difficult to defeat mountainous countries in warfare. America just experienced this in Afghanistan. Iran is very well defended simply by the nature of its topography. A ground invasion of Iran would be supreme folly.

The war at present: To the present, there have been some major developments in the conflict. The entire Resistance bloc – Hamas, Hezbollah, Ansar Allah (which the US likes to call the Houthis), Iraqi militias – are all now engaged in the war in some fashion, [are united and are openly collaborating](#). The Western narrative is that these resistance factions are all backed by Iran, whereas in reality they are all independent. But all of them have received help and have been supported in

their efforts by Iran in various ways and at various times. And they are all primarily Shia Islamist. Now, as a result of the unfolding war they have all engaged together in the conflict, seeing that the opportunity for finally pushing the US out of the region has arrived. Sunni factions are beginning to join with the Resistance, too, since Khamenei was assassinated and because they see how the US is treated the Persian Gulf literal states. They are all poised to join in operations where needed and in support of each other. Iran has not asked for their help, as they seem quite capable of inflicting damage upon the US and Israel in the region by themselves. For Iran, the war is no longer defensive, but instead has become pre-emptive, which will be explained shortly.

Hezbollah entered the war on the side of The Resistance in response to Israeli plans to occupy southern Lebanon up to the Litani River. The Israeli plans were completely upended and they have [not been able to make any gains in southern Lebanon](#). In fact Hezbollah has managed even to [occupy part of Kiryat Shmona in Israeli territory](#). Hezbollah has been firing volleys of missiles into northern Israel since they re-joined the conflict, primarily in Israel's north but also in points further south. These come in volleys several times a day. Prior to their proposed invasion of Lebanon the Israelis had been heavily bombing southern Lebanon and sections of Beirut where the Israelis believed Hezbollah was quartered.

Since Hezbollah entered the conflict [they have destroyed over 120 Israeli Merkava tanks](#). Their tactics are to allow the Israelis to enter Lebanon and literally to walk into a trap. There are reports of many evacuation helicopter flights to Israeli hospitals. The Israelis say that there have been only very few casualties on the Israeli side. But the evidence from sources outside Israel paints a different picture. As a sign of their desperation, the Israelis have been lobbying the Jolani so-called government in Syria to enter the fray against Hezbollah, but so far have not had any success. In fact Jolani [has decided to sit out the war unless they are attacked](#). Jolani and his gang in Syria have other problems. There are uprisings from resistance groups and [Kurds within Syria against the regime](#) in Damascus and [Israeli airstrikes in southern Syria](#), ostensibly to protect the Druze community. Jolani is not stupid, either, seeing increasingly he is being used as a tool and that his days may also be numbered.

The Israelis had completely misinterpreted the abeyance of hostilities from Hamas and Hezbollah, thinking they had been subdued. The two groups had been quietly reconstituting themselves instead, reorganizing their command, and rearming during the cease-fires, the latter which [the Israelis have consistently violated](#). Hamas [has been in open warfare with the Israeli-backed criminal gangs in Gaza](#) who have been used to prevent aid from coming into the Gaza Strip. The Israeli command is beside itself, with IOF officials reporting through the press that [the Israeli Army is at the breaking point](#). They do not have the manpower to confront the resistance groups or to execute their plans. Reservists refuse to show up for duty in large numbers. The [Orthodox Jews in Israel still refuse military service](#). Resistance is ongoing in the West Bank although [the toll on Palestinians there has been severe](#). And now with the law just passing the Knesset for the execution of Palestinian prisoners, [Hamas has called upon Hezbollah to capture IOF soldiers](#), stating that is the fastest way to secure release of Palestinian and Arab prisoners.

Ansar Allah has so far been fairly quiet in their actions against the Israelis and have as yet to close the Bab al-Mandeb Strait. The [word is that they are bored as a result](#). However [they have fired missiles into Israel](#). Their main position at this point seems to be to aid in preventing a land invasion of Iran. There had been reports of a possible land invasion of Yemen by the American forces to prevent closure of the Bab al-Mandeb Strait, but this has yet to materialize. [American forces are amassing in the region](#), and on the order of 30 to 40,000 special operations troops. They are unable to occupy the bases in the Persian Gulf region, because [those bases have been largely destroyed](#). Instead they are being put up in hotels, which are being struck by Iranian drones. Like the Israelis, the Americans report very few casualties, but in fact the numbers of American killed and wounded are actually quite high. We will cover that in the next letter. The pre-emptive phase of Iran's war is

to strike at the gatherings of American forces in the region before they can mount any invasion. There were reports of strikes against two amphibious landing forces, one in Kuwait and the other in the UAE, resulting in large numbers of casualties and destruction of the equipment.

The Iraqi resistance forces have been pummeling American posts in Iraq, with the [Victory Base in Baghdad undergoing repeated strikes](#). These units are operating asymmetrically under what has been dubbed the [Iraqi Fire Maneuvre](#) ([Telegram](#) for full description). The Americans have been pushed up to their base in Erbil in northern Iraq, which was to be a staging area for a land invasion of Iran. Thus far, the [Kurds are refusing to participate](#). There are scenes of [large convoys of Toyota pickups loaded with humanitarian aid headed into Iran from Iraq](#). The Iraqis and the Indians have been making large donations in support of Iran. I have been asked why this sort of thing could not have happened for the Palestinians in Gaza, and why the world has not forced Israel to stop the genocide. The answer is both simple and complicated.

The siege of Gaza has not been broken before now primarily because to force entry into Gaza would pit the forces seeking to do so against the combined militaries of the US and Israel. The thing is, Israel and the US are essentially the same entity with Israel being a *de facto* US state regarding security matters. The European elites (establishments) are essentially American vassals. It would have taken a united world alliance to force the US-Israeli project to back down. It has taken this long for the world to wake up to realities. Yes, there have been huge protests against the genocide. But peaceful protests do no change anything, as mentioned previously. It takes prolonged economic pressure (as in general strikes) to bring elites around. We had a small example of that with the Italian dock workers strike, mentioned in previous letters.

Western European nations, with a few exceptions, are all tied into what has come to be known as the Epstein Syndicate. They were duly warned against going against Israeli interests. We hear a few officials in those nations lament the fate of ‘those poor Palestinians’, but ‘Israel has a right to defend itself’, and other such rubbish. Neither Russia nor China could do anything much alone. Russia has its hands full fighting against the Anglo-American Empire in Ukraine. China is neutral in terms of its foreign policy and is too far away, Logistics would be a problem for them. They do not have the ‘reach’ the Americans do, and they have to guard their coast opposite Taiwan, where the Americans are threatening there. Iran could not do it alone.

It took the 12-Day War to show the Iranians their weakness in defences, which have since been rectified, as we are seeing. And both China and Russia are now helping them behind the scenes. Basically, there has been no united front against Israel and the US until now. And any attempts previously to halt the genocide would have been met with intensive economic pressure via sanctions for any nation acting against Israel. But Iran has been the key to breaking the siege. In terms of international law the Iranians had to wait to be attacked. We see the results of that strategy now, because the world has turned soundly against the US and Israel. That support would have been muted had Iran attacked first. There is huge interest and support for Iran worldwide, especially in the Global South, and especially in Asia, because they see how Iran has stood up against the Empire. As a result there are growing calls in Russia for the Russian General Staff to finish the job in Ukraine, which may in fact happen soon. The Western public has finally woken up as well, which was necessary before any form Western action could be taken against Israel and the US. And these are just the main points.

Returning to the rumoured invasion of Iran, though, the numbers of [American forces in the region are insufficient to execute a land invasion](#) of Iran or even one of the Iranian islands. Trump [had stated even in the 1980s](#) that the Americans should occupy Kharg Island for instance and seize part of Iran’s oil. Trump seems to have a real fetish about taking oil from other countries. The [islands off the coast of Iran have all been mined](#), are heavily fortified, have Iranian troops stationed there, and all lie within range of Iranian artillery on the Iranian coast. As was [stated in the previous letter](#) (Topic: “The Iranian

Strategy”), any attempt to invade the mainland Iran or even one or two the islands off the coast would be a fool’s errand. Perhaps at this point it may be of benefit to understand Iran’s astrology.

Iran’s astrology: The present national chart of Iran shows Aries Sun with Leo rising. The chart is set for 1 April 1979 at 14:00 Tehran time. ([chart](#)). The Moon is in Gemini square to Saturn, the latter which is retrograde in Virgo and opposing Venus. The Moon is the apex of the t-square formed by those planets, showing the serious nature of the government and the society. In addition we see Uranus in Scorpio, retrograde, and squaring the Iranian horizon axis. What we are looking at here is a very resilient and proud people who are unlikely to succumb to the external pressures being forced upon them. The chart represents a people who have had to learn valuable lessons, at the same time making creative use of those lessons, gained through hard experience. A primary misunderstanding of Iran is that it is a civilization, overlain by a national government and religion. P9

Iran is a very technically advanced society, quick to ascertain facts and to extract wisdom from them. This is shown by Mercury/Mars conjunction in Pisces. The conjunction is trine to Jupiter on one side and Uranus on the other side. Added to this, the Aries Sun is conjunct the dwarf planet Eris, both of which are opposed to Pluto. This is a dogged and very powerful combination when aroused. The Iranians are very careful strategic planners, which in fact is typical of civilizational states. Iran has [produced a military leadership composed of soldier-scholars](#). The conjunction of the Sun with Eris (Goddess of Discord, who accompanied Mars on the battlefield) gives them a very deep understanding of warfare and the enemies who confront them. The Iranians have certainly thrown Washington and Western leadership into discord.

Of particular interest in this current conflict is the position of Saturn in Virgo, which sits on the Virgo soul rulership of the Jews.⁵ Saturn is the purveyor of karma, as well as presenting opportunities for choosing a better path. Saturn is a restrictive influence in one sense, in that it hinders the selfish expression of the personality, or in the case of the Jews the soul expression, while yet presenting an opportunity for expressing a truer soul expression for the Jews. And to be clear, Zionism is anathema to the soul expression of the Jews. We might consider the following in relation to what is working out between Iran and the US-Israeli axis:

“I would point out here that the...energy, focussed in the Jewish problem, is definitely producing cleavage as a part of the divine Plan. The Jews are instruments in the working out of the Plan for the production of certain syntheses and to bring humanity to certain realisations and decisions...However, it only expresses the present situation in this interim period between the old Piscean age which is passing and the new Aquarian age which is coming in. It depicts this present world cycle.”⁶

We should remember that the battle over Palestine was fomented by the Zionists and not by the Jews as a whole. There is quite a bit we could outline in terms of the relationship of Iran with the administrations in Washington and Tel Aviv, but we do not have the space to do so here. There has been some conjecture about the rays that rule Iran, noting that anything we might say is conjecture at this point. However, we note a strong first ray influence, exhibited as the resilience of the Iranian people and their determination to advance their objectives in the face of sometimes very fierce opposition, as we are seeing today. There is also a strong fourth ray influence notable through their art and architecture, which is some of the most beautiful in the world. Anyone who has travelled to Iran can verify this latter point (see Eli video in Suggested Viewing).

The current government of Iran is Islamic, which carries the sixth Ray devotion to their cause, which is virtually erased from any reporting in the West, which instead likes to label Iranians as extremists and fanatics. The latter label can be rightly applied to the current Israeli populace and some of Israel’s more strident supporters in the US. Islam is not a permanent feature of Iran, though. It is more in the nature of an overlay, a temporary expression of what is actually the civilization of the Persian people, having existed for thousands of years. As the generations pass in Iran, they are becoming more secular, especially among the youth. Iran is an ancient fortress

geographically, notably contained within its mountain ranges which border both sides of the Iranian nation. Mountains impart a quality of strength and steadfastness,⁷ the ruggedness needed to overcome obstacles. We see that in people who live in all high mountain ranges across the world and in [nations that are primarily mountainous](#) – Afghanistan and China, for instance.

Iran is a society in the process of transformation, having taken its side with the emerging world and the liberation of the oppressed, whereas the materialistic powers of the West are seeking to maintain the passing order, an order which has failed its common people. We witness that failure in the increasing suffering of the common people in Western societies, the widening wealth gap and the increasing inability of people being able to make ends meet. We are generalizing here and there are many other factors at work, but these matters bear some thought. P10

Iran with its current government has always sided with the oppressed nations and people of the world – Cuba, Palestinians, Venezuelans, for instance. Yet we only hear about how oppressed the people of Iran are under the ‘mullahs’. If so, why have they not risen up and overthrown the present government? And if the old Iranian monarchists want a return of the Shah or similar leadership, then why was the Shah thrown out in the first place in 1979 and replaced with the present regime, as Washington insists on calling it? It is another matter worth research and contemplation. This war, like the Russian SMO, is instead awakening and instilling pride in the young people of both Russia and Iran and showing them who the true villains really are. Washington cares nothing for the people of Iran. They cannot even give a reasonable accounting of why this war was initiated, cannot enunciate a strategy, and certainly have no idea what to do after the fact even if they were even remotely able to prevail. There is no Plan B, C, D, etc. after the fact. Then there is the new Supreme Leader, who has appeared at a critical moment in Iran’s destiny..

The other Khamenei: With the assassination of Iran’s Supreme Leader, Ali Khamenei in the opening salvos of the war on Iran, the US and Israel had hoped for a collapse of the leadership in Iran. Their hopes were dashed almost immediately, when Iran began retaliating for the war. Along with the Supreme Leader, his wife, his daughter-in-law, a grandson, and other extended family members were also assassinated. His son, Mojtaba Khamenei was left as the preferred successor to the post. He was at the site when the elder Khamenei was assassinated, but was injured. Unlike his father, Mojtaba was not named as the successor in Ali Khamenei’s will. On 8 March the Assembly of Experts in Tehran [anointed Khamenei the younger as the new Supreme Leader of Iran](#). The IRGC preferred this man as their leader. He had military experience. He was closely associated with the IRGC. And he was something else – he represented continuation of his father’s legacy and of the revolution.

For astrologers, Mojtaba was born on 8 September 1969 in Mashhad, Iran. We do not have a time of day for his birth ([chart](#)). With that aside, Khamenei will be tough as nails with the Israelis and the US. There will be no negotiations with them nor will there be surrender. Khamenei has Virgo Sun, Leo Moon, with the Sun squared Mars, with Mars also squared to Pluto and with that latter base square forming a Finger of the World configuration, Saturn is at the apex of the configuration. In addition, Mars is out-of-bounds. It is a configuration that is very hard-nosed: “A person unafraid of hard work leaving no stone unturned in the pursuit of a particular task, the desire to overcome difficulties and obstacles at all cost forcibly.”⁸ This is a man who will see either Iran’s victory through to the end or its destruction. Given the way matters are going with the war, Iran’s victory is looming larger by the day, and quickly. Khamenei is well respected in the religious community. Given the aspects we see in his chart he will be a fearless opponent to the Western powers, much like his father. He is also expected to take a harder line toward the West than did his father.

Embracing a larger perspective, given what has been outlined above, what are we really looking at here? Consider the following, from the post-WWII era:

“The entire area of the Near East and Europe—Greece, Yugoslavia, Turkey, Palestine, the Arab States, Egypt and Russia—are under a heavy overshadowing cloud. Can that cloud be dissipated by the right thinking and planning of Great Britain, the United States and the majority of the United Nations or—must it break in disaster over the world? Will it present a task too hard for correct handling by that inexperienced disciple—Humanity?”

In what I have written above you have the picture of the true situation; it is one which finds Great Britain temporarily weakened and ineffective (except for the clear thinking of her people and her political maturity); it finds the United States, unused to power, somewhat arrogant, with a strong superiority complex, inexperienced and yet at the same time exceedingly well-intentioned and fundamentally sound. **It is the mass of the people who are sound in their thinking and not their representatives in Congress.**”⁹

Remembering Yugoslavia: The bolded text is the immediate concern of the American people, given the capture of Congress by financial and Zionist interests over decades and their complete fealty to Israel and those aforementioned interests. Yugoslavia, mentioned in the quote, is echoed in today’s war. [Yugoslavia was broken up at the end of the last century by NATO](#) forces because it represented opposition to the Western banking cartels and was outside the control of the Empire. It was also a prosperous socialist nation (Yes, America, there is such a thing.) aligned with the Soviet Union and which retained its alignment with the Russian Federation after the fall of the USSR. The latter is another reason why Washington saw fit to balkanize the former Yugoslav Republic.

It is worth noting, in echoing Trump’s war speech (above) that the bombing campaign for the seizure of Kosovo was more ferocious than anything the Americans and Israelis have been able to unleash on Iran in the present war and was only ended by Clinton when the weapons ran low. That campaign was based on false claims later proven to have been fabricated, just as this war is so based. The nuclear program in Iran is a clear fabricated ‘justification’ for going to war with Iran. Just as the Kosovo campaign soured relations with Russia and ended American involvement there, so has the bombing of Iran soured American relations with the wider world.

The ‘overshadowing cloud’ mentioned in the preceding quote relates to the fact that Nazism was not completely eradicated in WWII and was allowed influence in the US by the transfer of Nazis to the US after the war under American protection (Operation Paperclip) and into West Asia and Argentina. Zionism at present resembles Nazi ideology very much in the current Israeli state and in Ukraine. And as a result of Iran’s bombardment of Israel in the present war the Zionists are leaving Israel and are buying up territory – yes, we can call it that – in [Argentina, Bolivia and Chile, Cyprus](#) and the [Greek islands](#). [They are also establishing colonies in Ukraine](#). Zionist influence was one of the main reasons Zelenskyy was installed as President of Ukraine and why he has not been removed.

[Egypt and Jordan are currently under the thrall of the US](#) via IMF loans, Egypt being the custodian of the Suez Canal, a vital transport link and choke point. Yet there is news now that [60,000 Americans are being evacuated from Egypt due to regional tensions](#). Something is about to come down there. The cloud mentioned is in process of being broken up and dispersed in Palestine via this war and eventually throughout the whole of West Asia, only to be continued in Greece and a lesser extent in Turkey, continuing in Ukraine and Argentina. Europeans are gradually coming to the realization that they must ‘throw the bums out’, the feckless leaders who currently hold sway over EU policy. This war is doing much to precipitate that, as it is shattering NATO and driving a wedge between the US and EU. Nation after nation in Europe is [refusing to allow Americans to use their bases and air fields](#), even to allow overflights of their air space. However, there is an opportunity for the surrounding Arab states with Israel being weakened. It is conceivable they could mount a combined attack against Israel, but they rely on funding from the United States through the IMF to prop up their societies. Regarding the Arab states, Trump committed a huge faux pas when [he publicly insulted Bin Salman of Saudi Arabia](#). Arabs have a habit of revenge served cold after insults, biding their time for the right moment. That insult may come back to haunt Trump.

Old habits die hard: The folks in Washington are good at shock and awe and making war, though the tactic has failed with Iran. But they do not know how to keep a peace once a regime has been removed. They are like the dog chasing a car. What is the dog going to do after the car stops? In most cases the dog turns around and leaves. Or perhaps the dog makes friends with the driver of the car. If this comparison sounds ridiculous, remember Vietnam, Afghanistan, Iraq, and so on.

This operation on Iran rings very similar to what we saw with our war in Afghanistan, being [based in a lie, unjustified, extremely costly and in the end, replacing the Taliban with...the Taliban](#), at which point we had to beat an ignoble and hasty retreat. We were getting ready to provoke Russia into its invasion of Ukraine at that point and had to have our intelligence and forces focused there instead of Afghanistan. Almost six months after our retreat from Afghanistan we were taken into NATO's proxy war against Russia in Ukraine, fomented by Washington and London. This latter war has been highlighted many times in these letters over the past 4+ years, so we will not comment further on it here. P12

We do not realize that in the West, largely because we have been misinformed and kept in the dark, that our economies are fragile, having relied on the petrodollar scheme and the SWIFT international exchange system. The derivative financial system that was set up under neoliberal economics relies on resources that can be used as collateral for making loans. Oil is one of the major commodities that is used for such collateral. The security system under which the Anglo-American Empire had been set up relied on the Gulf monarchies and the Israelis to keep order within the region. This is why we have seen such vitriol and negative reporting on Iran ever since their revolution. To make what is happening very clear we must remember the following: If Iran is able to drive the US essentially out of the Middle East and cause the collapse of Israel as a major military influence in West Asia, then the entire neoliberal financialized economic system itself is at risk of collapse. That doesn't mean our societies will collapse. But it does mean that Western society in particular is going to be going through some revolutionary changes over the next years.

The outcome?: What we are likely to see as the outcome of this war is a humiliating military defeat for the Western powers and the end of the Anglo-American Empire. And yes, we all hear that Iran will collapse and that American forces will ultimately prevail. That looks more and more doubtful by the day if one follows media outside the West. But it would be wise to prepare oneself for what happens when the United States has to abandon its adventurism abroad and to bring its attention and its forces back onto the American mainland. If we go ahead with a land invasion of Iran – 'boots on the ground' – as is looking increasingly likely, the Iranian IRGC commanders are promising to take no prisoners. We would be on *their* land, threatening *their* families, having seen what we are doing to theirs. What do we realistically think would happen if the land invasion were to eventuate?

If you have family or friends deployed in the region there now, pray we see TACO once again and our troops are brought safely home instead of being 'welcomed' into Iran. No good would come of it. We are seen as terrorists there. Think on it. Even as of this writing, though, there are reports of copious flights of C-15 heavy transports flying back and forth from the Middle East. Those planes carry troops and heavy equipment. It would appear the decision to invade – somewhere, something – has been made. It would come as no surprise, though, that [all the talk of invading Iran is a feint for something else](#). Iraq, Syria and Lebanon come to mind, but we won't speculate here. We will know with more certainty by the next full moon. But if Trump's coterie of geniuses (not) greenlight this invasion of Iran and it all goes horribly wrong for us, what do we expect? The only escalation left is the nuclear one. Or Trump could magically get a dose of sense and bring everyone home. Don't count on it. This war is about vengeance for Trump and Washington.

The IRGC has another end goal in mind, which may be why the US troops are being sent to the region, again suspending speculation. If the war goes ahead as the Iranians see it, the final battle

will be in Jerusalem: That's correct, a land invasion of Israel by all the Resistance forces. The Iranians call Jerusalem 'al-Quds', "the City of the Holy Sanctuary." [They had this to say](#):

"...that it is pursuing a long-term strategy of attrition against US and Israeli forces, aimed at paving the way for a decisive confrontation and the broader objective of advancing toward occupied al-Quds."

Given the attitude of the majority of the Israeli public and the eschatological nature of the conflict to them and millions of Americans, an invasion of Israel would appear to be the only way to liberate Palestine and bring an end to Zionism in Israel at this point. Matters can change quickly and in unexpected directions in war, though, so we will have to wait and see. P13

The American front: There is rebellion in the ranks of the War department in Washington. [Americans need to consider the following](#) on the home front:

"Soldiers talk, and the talk on social media from active duty and retired US Army Rangers and others is largely expressing shock and outrage over the forced resignations of Gen. Randy A. George, Gen. David M. Hodne and Maj. Gen. William "Bill" Green Jr. The word on the street is that General George opposes launching a ground attack in Iran... This move by Hegseth — which was fully coordinated with White House Chief of Staff Susie Wiles — is, at a minimum, a further sign of the politicization of the Department of Defense, err, I meant the Department of War. Since the acronym of the Secretary of War is SOW, can we refer to Hegseth as the Chief Pig? Sorry for the ad hominem, but I could not resist. Seriously, this kind of political housecleaning is the continuation of a trend that started in earnest under Barack Obama. The very last thing the US needs is a politicized military...one that acts more like a Praetorian Guard, whose sole mission is to protect and serve a president based on partisan political considerations rather than protect and defend the Constitution."

Further on from that, from the same article:

"The shake-up in the Trump administration is not confined to the military. Trump also fired Attorney General Pam Bondi last night and *The Atlantic* reports, citing sources familiar with White House planning, that discussions are underway about the possible departure of Director of National Intelligence Tulsi Gabbard, FBI Director Kash Patel, Army Secretary Daniel Driscoll, and Labor Secretary Lori Chavez-DeRemer from the Trump administration. These personnel moves — if they happen — may signal something beyond jettisoning people who are not enthusiastic about putting troops on the ground in Iran...Getting rid of Kash Patel and Labor Secretary Chavez-DeRemer could be a play by Chief of Staff Susie Wiles, who is reading dismal polling data and wants to re-configure the Trump team with less controversial figures, and wants a makeover with an eye on the November mid-term election."

The first bit in the preceding quotes is more concerning. The danger there is that with a politicized military the removal of a president is much harder. Such an army will be more willing to support a president in quashing protests and insurrections. It is yet another step toward fascism. The reason the oath in the military is to the Constitution instead of the President is precisely for keeping the balance of powers and protecting the country and the rule of law instead of the President. The patriotic military people I have seen and heard are appalled at what Hegseth is doing, and angry. Of course, Hegseth is a sycophant and will do as Trump tells him. The other matter being violated under Hegseth's tenure is the separation of church and state (Constitution) and freedom of religion (Bill of Rights). The United States was not founded on 'Judeo-Christian values'. The latter narrative has entered the American discourse via Zionism-creep. The second paragraph of the quote relates to the midterms and was predicted before Trump even entered office for this 2nd term. The pundits who know Washington saw it coming a mile away. Beware, America! There is one more topic about which we should be aware, one of existential importance, which is being considered in the halls of power in Washington and Tel Aviv as this war goes rapidly 'further south' for the US.

The folly of using nukes: We are hearing increasing talk of the possible use of nuclear weapons against Iran. That in itself is a sign of the desperation the Americans and Israelis have regarding

their efforts to subdue Iran. The Iranians do not seem to be concerned about the possibility of a nuclear weapon being used against them. In fact in [a recent interview the mayor of the Hormozgan Province](#) in southern Iran stated that if the Israelis or the Americans might try to do so the Iranians may have a surprise waiting for them if they do, implying, perhaps that they might be able to respond in kind. Ted Postol from MIT recently outlined (see Suggested Viewing) why that might be entirely possible. The Iranians have enough enriched uranium to produce 11 small nuclear weapons in three weeks' time. I would recommend watching the video. It is visceral and not easy to view, but it goes to show the madness of even proposing to use such a weapon against Iran.

In fact, the Israelis would have to use many such tactical nuclear weapons to even touch Iran's critical military facilities. The Israelis allegedly have at least 200 nuclear weapons which they have produced at their Dimona site since the 1960s. The Americans under the Johnson administration encouraged it. However, even if the Israelis or Americans used nuclear weapons against Iran, doing so would guarantee the complete obliteration – Trump's favorite word regarding nukes these days – of Israel. Eleven small nukes would handily do the job, according to Postol. Given the present situation it is quite possible, seeing that the elder Khamenei has been assassinated, that Iran has already begun the processes necessary to produce such weapons. Pray it never comes to that. The entire region would be poisoned with radiation for years to come.

The prospect of the use of such weapons is actually doubtful, but we will parse that here. Some history is in order. It is widely thought and has been promoted as such that Israel obtained the bomb through sheer grit, French assistance and German reparations money. [According to a recent investigative article](#) (must read), the story is a carefully crafted one of national survival against impossible odds, which has been imprinted on Western consciousness by Hollywood, the MSM, and academic historical propaganda. **It is also, on close inspection, almost certainly a fairytale.** The history that follows is taken from that article, verified from other sources.

JFK and Israel's nukes: The one man who might have stopped the development of the Israeli nuclear program from crossing the threshold to the bomb was shot dead in Dallas. No president after him ever asked questions about Israel's nuclear program again. What the Israeli nuclear weapon has done is to give the United States a supposed nuclear proxy in the Middle East while maintaining the precious fiction of plausible deniability. This is important to note. Providing plausible deniability for Washington is one of Israel's primary functions. Over time the relationship between Washington and Tel Aviv has become the toxic and parasitic relationship we see today. But without the United States Israel as it is today would probably not exist. The Israelis in their hubris seem to think otherwise, that they have the US over a barrel. Through blackmail and economic coercion they have certain politicians in thrall. But that is changing, and rapidly as a result of the genocide in Gaza and the present war.

The Dimona nuclear reactor was built by the French. By the end of the 1950s some 2,500 French citizens were living in Dimona, making it a nuclear boomtown. At first it was called a textile plant, later a metallurgical research institute and finally an agricultural research station. It wasn't until 1969 that Dimona was finally dubbed a nuclear research center for desalination. You can't make this stuff up. France served as Washington's cut-out in the development of Israel's nuclear industry. This was done to avoid Congressional oversight, with the facility having violated the Atomic Energy Act. France's cooperation ended with Israel in 1968 when De Gaul took France out of NATO's integrated command structure.

The delivery systems for this nuclear weapon are the Jericho class of missiles, the biggest of which has a range of 11,500 km, which means it can reach the entire Middle East, Africa, Europe, Asia and almost all parts of North America as well as large parts of South America and North Oceania. Those missiles are buried very deeply underground in hardened silos, but concentrated in a small area. But the technology is Israeli in name only. So, the Israelis are able to strike anywhere within

the Eurasian landmass, Africa, and everywhere in the Americas except for the furthestmost Western regions. Californians are safe from Israeli nukes – Aussies, not so much. Those missiles can also strike Western Australia. The Israelis also have their version of a nuclear triad of delivery systems, including submarines, nuclear artillery and aircraft.

In 1973 we had the Israeli version of the Cuban missile crisis, when Syrian tanks rolled toward the Golan Heights. At the time Moshe Dayan told the Prime Minister Golda Meir that the situation at the time could mean the end of the Third Temple. ‘Temple’ was code for nuclear weapons. Meir authorized the deployment of 13 nuclear warheads, easily detectable, as a signal to the United States: “Either send help or we start World War III.” Washington got the message and agreed to send massive hardware to replace that which had been destroyed in the war. It was a small coup for Israel and began the road in large fashion for the program of roping the US Congress firmly under Israel’s wing.

Coming to today, with the perspective from history, the Soviets knew from early on about Dimona. Then in 1967 they flew directly over the Dimona nuclear facility on a reconnaissance mission, confirming that Israel was closer to the bomb than anyone had admitted. By June 3, 1967, two days before the ‘67 war broke out, Soviet strategic bombers were on high alert with their targets having been selected inside Israel. Moscow was prepared to go to war to stop Israel’s bomb. The Soviets backed off when the United States threatened nuclear retaliation against the Soviets if they bombed the Israeli facilities. At that time during the Cold War the Soviets were backing many of the Arab states. None of this saga would have been made public without the whistleblowers who risked everything to expose it.

The evidence was incontrovertible: Israel had developed between one hundred and 200 nuclear warheads, including thermonuclear weapons. The estimated weekly production at the facility was enough for 4 to 12 nuclear weapons every year. The story was broken by a man with the surname Vanunu, who was an employee at that the facility who was about to be laid off. He took 57 photos within the facility and blew the lid off the secrecy of the project. The man who exposed Vanunu was the one and only Robert Maxwell – yeah that one. But when push comes to shove, the *threat* of the use of nuclear weapons by Israel is almost certainly hasbara, though in itself an effective deterrent. What about today, though, regarding Israel’s nukes? Well, times have changed. Russia is watching those developments very closely. Pakistan has promised to use a nuke on Israel if Iran is nuked. And the world knows Israel and the US are the aggressors in this war and have come out on the side of Iran. Using a nuclear weapon on Iran would turn both Israel and the US into pariah states – except Israel would no longer exist.

Closing remarks: Ted Postol had some closing remarks in his interview mentioned previously about the war, Israel, its nukes, and Israel’s future. Postol is also of Jewish background. We close this letter with his closing words:

“I think the war from the point of view of the Israelis and the Americans has already been lost and that doesn’t mean that Israel has to cease as a state. Israel can survive as a state but it has to adopt a different attitude toward Iran. Israelis have to say we have to live and let live. We don’t have to agree with the Iranian system of government. We don’t have to like them. We don’t have to love them. But we need to respect their right to exist as a great nation. And unless we reach that understanding and we help them understand that we mean it, we’re not going to turn again. We’re not going to try another sneak attack. We’re not going to make believe we’re negotiating and attack them like we did to Hezbollah in Qatar or like we did in in February. We cannot continue this way. We need to establish credibility as a negotiating state who acts according to the diplomatic rules that have been established since Ivan the Terrible was eventually, you know, overtaken by civilization and diplomacy. You cannot continue operating this way.

You are not the chosen people that you think you are. You are a people who have a great culture. You have great accomplishments. You have every reason to be proud of those accomplishments. But you have no right to be murderous in this way. And you

have no right to disrespect the rights of other countries who also want to survive on their own. And you need to accept that. And you need to transmit that to the world and in particular to Iranians because right now if I were Iranian I would not believe a thing you're saying diplomatically and if I don't believe it I'm going to stay at the wheel and I'm going to continue these attacks and it will eventually result in terrible damage to Israel beyond the terrible damage that has already occurred. And anyone who thinks that terrible damage has not occurred to Israel has been smoking banana peels and is just not understanding what this reality is.

The economy of Israel is a shambles. And incidentally, I should say as an American. I don't think of myself as an American Jew, but I do come from a Jewish background. I think of myself as an American, not as an American Jew. But I can tell you as an American, Americans are fed up with Israel. Israel does not have this relationship with the American population that it used to have. I talk to Americans all the time who say, "I'm not going to war to defend those Israelis, and I'm not going to be sucked into a war to defend those Israelis." So, Israelis who think that they're going to be on the gravy train after this thing happens better think twice because the American population is rethinking and I mean the population and I'm not only talking about Americans who are non-Jews. I'm talking Americans who are Jews. And like I say, I do not think of myself as an American Jew. I think of my wife as a Catholic. I don't think of myself in these terms. But I can tell you that I know a lot of American Jews and I'm not alone in the view that these guys in Israel have taken advantage of the United States and I'm finished with them and a lot of other Americans are and they better think about that because they have an economy that they have to rebuild and the amount of help that they may be expecting to get is very unlikely to be what they've been getting in the past. That's my expectation."

His views are shared by many of us. We will leave this letter with these thoughts. Until next time, have a safe and happy Easter. We will have a closer look at the emerging order in the next letter.
